THE SEARCH

The Program Director of the Physician Assistant Program (“Director”) will oversee all personnel management, faculty development, ARC-PA Accreditation standards and reviews, program development, curricular development, fiscal, academic, strategic planning, and day-to-day management of the PA Program. This position reports to the Dean of Arts and Sciences.

The University is a private, Catholic institution with 3900 students including 70 students in the Physician Assistant Program.

This is a 12-month, full time position.

QUALIFICATIONS

Minimum Qualifications

The program director must be a PA or a physician. a) If the program director is a PA, s/he must hold current NCCPA certification. b) If the program director is a physician, s/he must hold current licensure as an allopathic or osteopathic physician in the state in which the program exists and must be certified by an ABMS- or AOA-approved specialty board.

Preferred Qualifications

- Doctorate in health-related field.
- Administrative experience in Physician Assistant education.
- Clinical experience as a Physician Assistant.
